August 16, 2017 – Email requesting pre-proposals sent out.

September 1 through November 17, 2017:

- Optional opportunities to meet with small group of growers to discuss research ideas. September 6th and 7th are preferred dates, but other dates can be scheduled. (Contact David Torgerson for more information if interested at 218-253-4311 ext. 1)

12:00 p.m. November 22, 2017:

December 13, 2017:

- Researchers present pre-proposal to MN Wheat Research Committee at the Alerus Center in Grand Forks, ND.
- MN Wheat Research Committee reviews pre-proposals and prioritizes them, then calls for full proposals from top ranking pre-proposals.

December 15, 2017 Researchers notified to submit full proposal

January 18, 2018 Full proposals are due electronically, send to (gpodenski@gvtel.com and torgerso@gvtel.com)

January 30, 2018 Research Committee reviews full proposals and recommends funding to MN Wheat Council Board

January 30, 2018 MN Wheat Council acts on committee recommendations at their board meeting

January 31, 2018 PI's and researchers notified of MN Wheat Council funding decisions.

Note: Pre-proposals are different from a full proposal, in that the pre-proposal does not require being processed through university/organization sponsored programs, or granting/budgeting. If a full proposal is requested of the project after a presentation has been made to the Research Committee, then the normal channels for a proposal must be gone through.
